**SUMMARY OF MATERIAL MODIFICATIONS**

This Summary of Material Modifications describes important changes to the Summary Plan Description ("SPD") of the Roofers' Local No. 33 Insurance Fund ("the Fund"), as restated and amended through November 1, 2015. Effective April 1, 2022  
**LASIK Surgery**

The Trustees are pleased to announce that the Fund has added a LASIK benefit for eligible participants and dependents. For eligible LASIK surgery performed on or after April 1, 2022, the Fund will provide up to \$1,500 in reimbursement for each eye. To obtain the benefit, a participant or dependent must provide documentation of the procedure and proof of payment to the Fund Office.

The LASIK benefit is subject to the following conditions. If you fail to meet any of these requirements, the Fund will not provide reimbursement.

1. The participant or dependent who receives the treatment must be eligible for health insurance with the Fund at the time the procedure is performed.
2. The Fund will only provide reimbursement for payments made. If you pay less than \$1,500 per eye for your LASIK surgery, you will be reimbursed only for the amount that you paid.
3. The Fund will only provide reimbursement for a LASIK procedure performed by a licensed professional.
4. The Fund will not provide more than \$1,500 in reimbursement for LASIK surgery, for each eye on which the procedure is performed. This limitation applies for the individual's lifetime. (For example, a participant who receives \$3,000 in reimbursements for LASIK surgery in 2022 cannot receive further reimbursement for LASIK surgery in 2024).
